Pilgrimage Bus Transportation Information & Schedule

All bus seats are \$30 per person, with the exception of Bus #1 from Huntington and Charleston, which will be an overnight trip. The cost for the overnight trip is \$190 for one person and \$40 for each additional person per room, up to four people. This price includes the bus, hotel and breakfast.
