


Our Lady of Fatima Parish Census Update

As part of the Parish Census now being conducted to update our Parish Database, we are ready to implement the parishioner interface to the Database. The system is called “My Own Church” and is found on

our website (www.ourfatimafamily.com) and at <https://connectnow.parishsoft.com/wheelingcharleston>

Individual church members must register for a User Name and Password to access the “My Own Church” website. Click the **New User** button.

Click on the small arrow by Organization and find “Our Lady of Fatima Parish, Huntington.”

Complete the fields on the *New User Registration Form*. Required fields are marked with a red asterisk *.

Multiple email addresses are requested because the system must match an email address to identify the family in the database. (If you need to update your email before you register, you can email Sandy at smauk@olofatima.org).

Click **Register**.

Once you click **Register**, your registration will be submitted to the church staff for review.

After the church staff member accepts your registration, you will receive an email containing your User Name and Temporary Password.

Use your new User Name and Password to log into “My Own Church”. Here you can see your family record as well as your giving history. Later we will add your ministries.

You will also have access to the Pictorial Directory for the Parish.

Note that addresses and phone numbers are only shown if you allow it. If you need to make a change, contact the Parish Office, submit your updated Census Forms or update your own family record here. Add a small photo of your family and of family members so everyone can identify you! Contact Sandy, as above, or the Parish Office at 304-525-0866 if you have any problems.
